ORDER

12-3-2007: The PIO, Shri H.Mawrie is present and the complainant Shri D.Lamo is also present in the Commission today.

The PIO submitted a written show cause explaining the reason for delay of 10 (ten) days in furnishing the information to the appellant. According to the PIO the appellant filed the petition on 22-12-2006 not to him but to the office. Due to Christmas etc. holidays started from 23rd December till the end of the month the application for information could not be put up to him by the office. In fact the application came to his notice on 7-1-2007 and the information was supplied within 30 days of receipt of his application on 1-2-2007. Regarding the issue of cash receipt for Rs.10/- the PIO stated that the same has not been collected by the applicant though was entered in the Receipt Book of the Department and the amount already credited to the Treasury. The appellant present agreed that he submitted his request for information to the office and not to the PIO directly and stated that the information supplied to him was not complete or satisfactory.

Having heard both the parties and having considered the grounds for delay put forth by the PIO, the Commission decided that sufficient ground exists for condoning the delay in the present case and cautioned the PIO against repeating such delay in future. The Commission also advised the appellant to file a complaint before the Commission in case he is satisfied that the information supplied is incomplete or misleading or false.

Case disposed of.
