ORDER

20-8-2008: Seen the appeal petition dated 8-8-2008 received from Shri S. Sunar of Bishnupur, Shillong. Through this instant appeal petition, the appellant has sought revision of this Commission's decision dated 24-7-2008 in case No. MIC/Appeal/47/2008/7. In the original appeal dated 8-7-2008 the appellant has sought the intervention of the Commission against failure on the part of the PIO/DAA to treat the information sought by him as one which concerns his life or liberty as provided U/S 7(1) of the RTI Act, 2005 and hence to be furnished within 48 hours. The Commission having examined the nature of information bearing on the life or liberty of the appellant found that except the item at serial 6 & 7 of the original application submitted to the PIO the rest are not information as contemplated under the RTI Act and therefore the Commission finds no merit in the appeal to warrant the intervention. The Review Petition does not indicate any fresh grounds for review of the Order and therefore the Review Petition is rejected. The Review Petitioner may have to take recourse to normal procedure of appeal/complaint U/S 18(1)(b)(c) or by way of an appeal under the provision U/S 19(1) for refusal/failure to get a decision on item at serial 6 & 7 as the original RTI application dated 6-6-2008.

Appeal disposed of.
